<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The project was focused on discovering of cultural diversity of European nations, on connecting different people, and on emphasizing the importance of the European Union. Throughout the project participants learned foreign languages by mutual communication. They learned about the European Union also and European awareness was developed. Significant part of the project was the presentation of culture and arts which resulted in creation of informal bonds among nations. Participants also learned about tolerance and solidarity with others nations, between generations, genders and with minorities. Activities of the project were implemented during 7 days long event. We</p>			

can divide them into the following themes:

- Welcome address – activities focused on familiarization of the participants, introduction into the project themes
- Artistic diversity – activities focused on presentation of arts related to majority and the minorities
- Solidarity – activities focused on discussions, exchange of experiences, searching for solutions related to the post-covid atmosphere in society and solidarity among the citizens
- Civic engagement – activities focused on activation of citizens, volunteering and work in favour of local communities
- Integration and overcoming prejudices – activities focused on finding links between majority and minorities and overcoming prejudices, building tolerance and solidarity
- Cultural diversity – activities focused on the presentation of cultural diversity of European nations
- Europe and us – activities focused on workshops and discussions about the future of the EU, European values and learning about the EU.

These themes reflected the daily activities = one theme was designed for one day of project implementation.
